
Join Captain Clameron's Excursions on October 4th, 2018 for a customized guided mushroom hike/hunt/demo, at a place called Wilder.* This area of the Pacific Northwest has had recent sightings of Chanterelle Mushrooms, Cauliflower, King Bolete, Porcini, Hedgehog, Lobster, and more. We also have black bear, cougar, and elk, so don't forget your camera!

Designed exclusively with our group in mind, we will walk along a gravel road and have multiple opportunities to hike off-trail. We will **meet at 12:45 pm** in front of the Wolf Tree Taproom. Please wear **sturdy footwear, dress in layers, and bring rain gear** just in case -- it is the Oregon Coast in October! Please **use the restroom beforehand, bring extra drinks & snacks, plus personalized bags and baskets for your treasures**, if you desire. Our excursion includes a detailed demonstration (before & after), water, snacks and a bucket for all of your treasures. The live cooking demo at the end is Cameron's favorite, when we taste the freshness of harvest! We can then discuss local recipes, cooking suggestions, preserving methods, and anything else that comes to mind. Our excursion will end at approximately 3 pm.

Cameron is an enthusiastic naturalist with over a decade of experience (2006-2018) as a Park Naturalist, Thematic Interpretive Guide, and Park Ranger with the Oregon Parks and Recreational Department. He has provided demonstrations for the Oregon State Fair, Oregon Coast Aquarium, OMSI, Yachats Agate Festival, as well as having given daily Crabbing and Clamming Excursions, Junior Ranger Programs, and Guided Bridge Walk tours at the Historic Alsea Bay Bridge Interpretive/Visitors Center in Waldport, Oregon.
